Course Aim

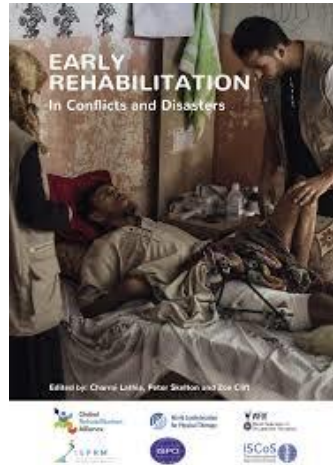
To provide rehabilitation professionals with the appropriate clinical knowledge, attitude and skills to provide safe and effective clinical care for patients injured during war.

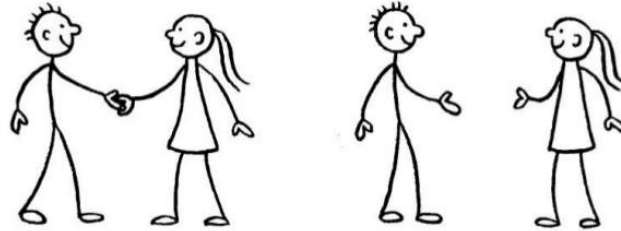
